PRESENTATION

Note that the allotted times shown in the program include 5 minutes for discussion (e.g., the 15-minute parallel session talks are 10+5 min).

Each room will be equipped with a PC (English WinXP, with PowerPoint Viewer2003 and Adobe Reader 8 installed) connected to an LCD projector (1024x768).

Bring your talk, either PPT or PDF, on a CD or on a USB memory. Be sure to embed all non-standard fonts in the PPT (PDF) file. Above PCs **do not** connect to Internet.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: There will be **NO Over Head Projectors**. Your OHP slides must be scanned and pasted on a PPT/PDF file before you come to Tokyo.

We do allow you to connect your own PC/Mac, through a 4-port display (VGA) switcher. Be sure to test the connection before your session.

We will collect your PPT/PDF files and make them available to participants on our web site. Follow the instructions of the session organizers.

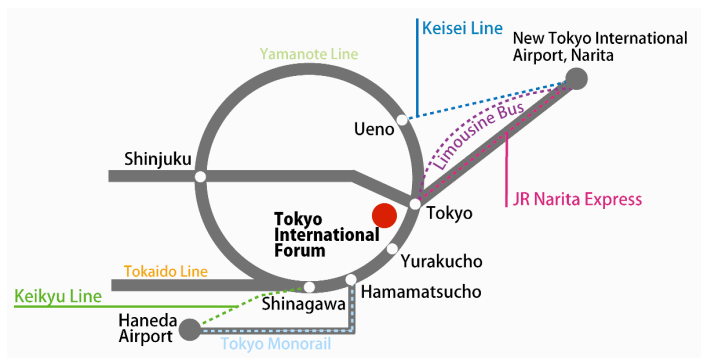

Access to TIF

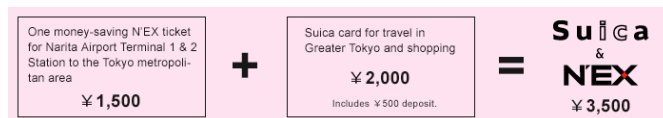
Access information from New Tokyo International Airport (Narita) to the conference site, Tokyo International Forum, is available in the venue page of our web site:

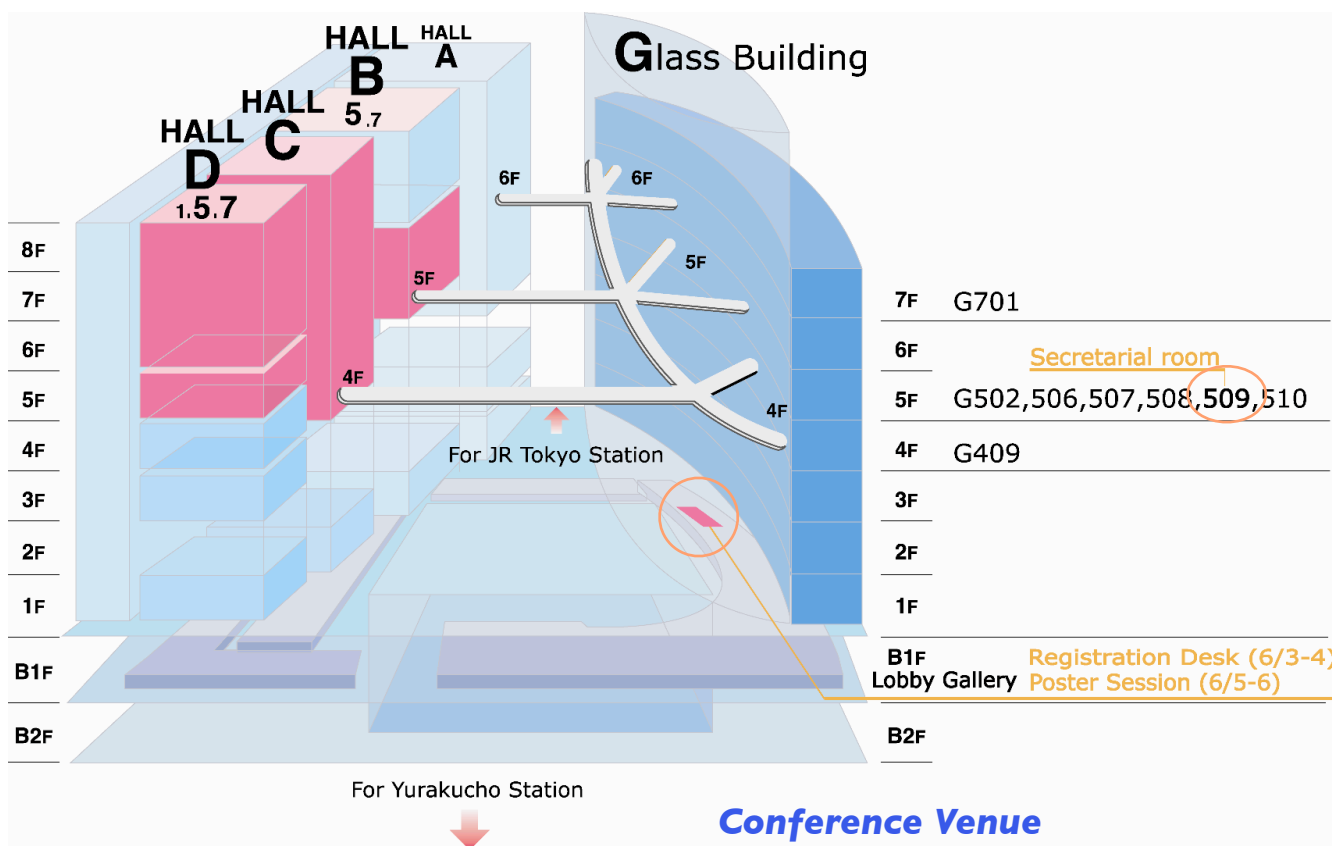
